Your Child's Lunch Account

This year each student will have a meal account accessible to them through their student ID number. Families can manage their child's account through www.schoolcafe.com. At this website you can add funds, check balances, view purchases, and set notifications. We also accept cash and checks at the register to avoid service fees. Your child accesses their account by using their student ID number. After picture day, each student will receive a picture ID card with a bar code, which they can use at the café line to be scanned in lieu of entering their ID number.
